

ABOUT US



The National Rodeo Association (NRA) Limited is a registered Australian non-profit organisation established in 1966. Serving as the governing body, the NRA affiliate with numerus Rodeo Committees across Queensland and New South Wales to host their rodeo events. This year, membership levels have exceeded 800, with most members actively participating in over 100 rodeos scheduled under the NRA banner throughout the rodeo season.

The rodeo season commences in late December each year and culminates with the National Finals Rodeo (NFR), the premier event of the season. The NFR serves as the ultimate showcase of skill, determination and passion of the best national competitors in each rodeo discipline. These elite athletes qualify after a grueling season of competing at rodeos throughout the country, accumulating points to rank among the top 12 competitors in their respective events. The NFR consists of three exhilarating rounds, where the top 12 competitors compete for coveted title of National Champion.

Previously, these rounds have been held at different venues across Southeast Queensland in November and December. However, in an exciting new development for 2024, the NRA have partnered with the Canungra Show Society to host all three rounds of the NFR at the Canungra Showgrounds on 29-30 November 2024. This revies the tradition of holding the NFR at a single, central location, reminiscent of the early days of rodeo.

The NFR is more than just the climax of the season—it is a celebration of the sport's rich heritage and a reflection of its bright future. This event attracts competitors, spectators, and enthusiasts from all across the country, creating an electric atmosphere that captures the heart and spirit of rodeo. As the most anticipated rodeo of the season, the NFR delivers thrilling, high-stakes competition and unforgettable entertainment.

CANUNGRA HISTORY



In 1938, a group of Canungra locals came together with a shared vision: to establish the Canungra Agricultural, Horticultural, and Industrial Society. Their main objective was to organise the first Canungra Show. A 440-yard ring had been built, and a combined sports and show day was held on November 5th, 1938 (pictured above). The community's overwhelming enthusiasm for the event led to further developments, including the construction of a pavilion, improvements to the dressing shed, and strong community involvement in running the event. However, in 1939 the Show was interrupted by the outbreak of World War II and Australia's involvement. While the Show continued in 1940 and 1941, with profits shared between the Show Society and the Patriotic Funds, all subsequent Shows were halted for the remainder of the war. In 1946, as the district began to recover, the Show made a successful return. Since then, the Canungra Show has become an annual tradition, evolving to reflect the community.

The first Canungra Rodeo was introduced in July 1992 (original newspaper listing below) as an addition to the growing roster of community events and quickly established itself as annual
