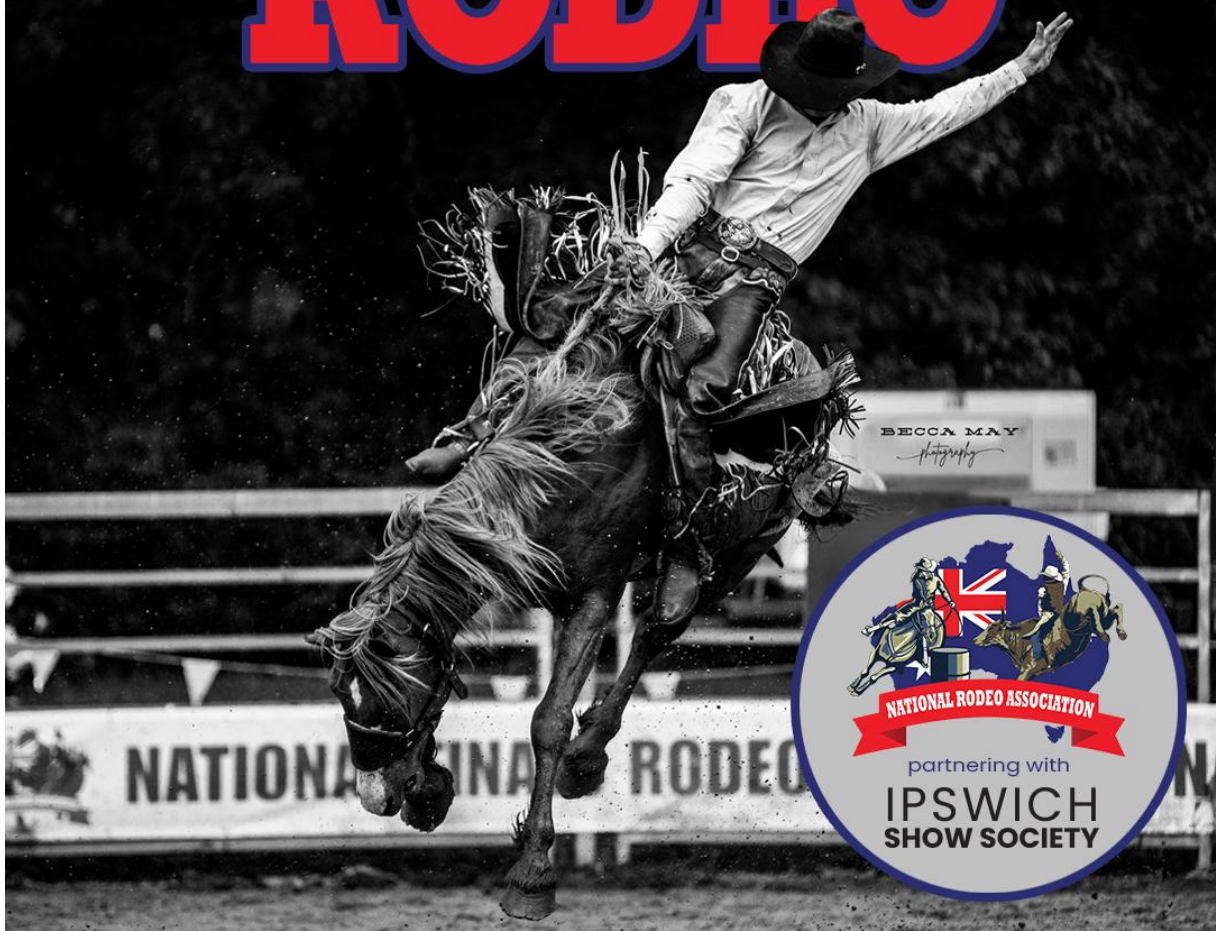

TICKETS

Competitors will receive their ticket via their email address.

All junior competitors will receive a complimentary ticket for their parent/guardian.

Tickets will be scanned in exchange for an event armband, which must be worn at all times while on site.

ARRIVAL

Competitors can arrive at the following times:

4:30 PM – 6:30 PM on Thursday 20th November

12:00 PM – 3:00 PM on Friday 21st November

Competitors with horses are to enter via Gate 2, located on Parker Avenue.

Competitors without animals are to enter via Campground A, located on Parker Avenue.

All vehicles must display the vehicle pass (included in this document) at all times while on site.

Please ensure the pass is completed with your name and contact details before arrival.

REPORT TO RODEO SECRETARY - NRA TO COMPLETE

All competitors must pay nominations and pick up back numbers before competing.
The Rodeo Secretary is located in the Grandstand Pavilion.

BIOSECURITY REQUIREMENT – HORSE COMPETITORS - NRA TO COMPLETE

All horse competitors must complete a Horse Health Declaration / Movement Record and/ NVD (National Vendor Declaration) provide it to **NRA** upon placing nominations via email to office@nationalrodeoassociation.com.au.

This is a mandatory requirement to ensure the safety and wellbeing of all animals on site.

SMOKING

Smoking is only permitted in designated areas. This includes the Designated Outdoor Smoking Area (DOSA) located in the Main Arena.

DEPARTURE

All competitors must depart from the grounds by 10:00 am on Sunday morning.
On departure remove all rubbish and surplus materials leaving the site clean and tidy.

CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL

The consumption of Alcohol in camping areas is strictly prohibited.
Alcohol may only be consumed within the licensed area and during licensed hours.

SPEED LIMIT

Speed limit for vehicles on the Showgrounds is 10 kph. Any reckless driving will not be tolerated.

Shared Roadways: Please be advised that the Ipswich Showgrounds precinct is a shared facility and as such the roadways are shared with vehicles and pedestrians. Vehicles must always give way to pedestrians.

Unregistered motor vehicles, caravans, trailers etc. are not permitted on site.

CAMPING SITES

All sites are non-powered.

Pegs or anchor stakes can only be driven into the ground to a **maximum depth of 300mm** to avoid damage to underground electricity, water, and communication services.

CAMPING QUIET TIME

10:00 PM – 7:00 AM

To ensure a restful environment for all competitors, horses, and guests — and to be respectful of our neighbours — please keep noise to a minimum during these hours.

Competitors must remain within the campsite from 10:30 pm on Thursday, 11:00 pm on Friday, and 12:30 pm on Saturday. Access to bathroom facilities will be permitted.

ELECTRICAL LEADS

All persons staying at the Ipswich Showgrounds are responsible for all electrical leads, tools, and appliances being recently tagged and tested by a licensed electrical contractor. All guests MUST abide by the provisions of the Workplace Health & Safety Act, its regulations and all relevant compliance and advisory standards.

NOT ALLOWED ON SITE:

No open fires

No artificial noise makers

No dogs

No glass containers

No BYO alcohol

SECURITY NOTICE

Security personnel will be on site, including overnight patrols. However, the security of your personal belongings remains your responsibility. Please take all necessary precautions to protect your property.

If you require security during the event, please approach one of the guards patrolling the site — they are stationed throughout the venue. You may also visit the Public Safety Office for assistance.
